## 03. "Justification"

## You are seen and declared as "not guilty" in God's eyes because of the shed blood of Christ.

(Romans 3:23-24 NKJV) "for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, {24} being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus,"

(2 Corinthians 5:21 NKJV) "For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him."

(Romans 4:6-8 NKJV) "just as David also describes the blessedness of the man to whom God imputes righteousness apart from works: {7} "Blessed are those whose lawless deeds are forgiven, And whose sins are covered; {8} Blessed is the man to whom the LORD shall not impute sin.""

The <u>only way</u> to gain God's declaration of justification is to have faith in Christ as Lord and Savior.

- God justifies you by declaring He will not blame you for what you did, because Jesus took the blame.
- God gives you Christ's righteousness.
- God declares that you are entitled to all the advantages and rewards that come from obedience to His righteous requirements (Romans 8:1 & 2).
