ACTS 9:1-9

Question #1 “Verse 5: “Who are You Lord?”

Question #2 “Verse 6: “Lord, what do you want me to do?”

Saul asked two questions we need to ask every day. He missed his opportunity to ask a third question. This was the most important question he could have asked:

Question #3 “Lord, who do you want me to become?”

God knows that when we become who He wants us to become, we will do what He wants us to do.

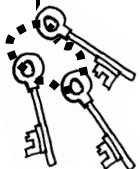
What are the determining factors in “becoming?” They are many, but three stand out:
[1] Integrity, [2] Righteousness... and above all else, [3] your faithful commitment!

Faithful commitment requires there can be no looking back or “Plan B.” → **PHILIPPIANS 3:12-14**

You must determine to be a lifelong “becomer.” How do you do this?
