Scripture Reference	DO	BE
1 Timothy 1:18-19	Do wage a good warfare. (Do fight the Lord's battles well.)	Be a person of faith and good conscience. (These are the characteristics of an excellent warrior for the Lord.)
2 Timothy 2:4	Do keep the affairs of this life in proper perspective. Give priority to God's affairs.	
1 Timothy 4:12-15	Do read the Word; exhort others, teach doctrine and nurture your gifts.	Be an example to believers in word conduct, love, spirit, faith and purity.
1 Timothy 5:19-22	Do confront sin without hesitation. Keep yourself pure.	Be cautious about what you believe and fair toward all, without prejudice
1 Timothy 6:11-12	Do pursue the good fight of faith.	Be a person of righteousness and purity, imitating Christ as best as you can. Be gentle and humble before everyone.
2 Timothy 2:22-25	Do show faith, love, patience and gentleness.	Be prepared to teach what you have learned.
2 Timothy 1:13	Do hold tightly to the patterns of teaching (and the principles they represent) that your mentors have given you.	Be a faithful steward of the Word of God.
2 Timothy 1-2	Do imitate those things you have heard your mentors teach about.	Be a mentor like the person God provided to mentor you.
2 Timothy 2:15-16	Do study the Word with diligence. Interpret it as best as you can. It will be an effort, but do it unto the Lord. He will be proud of you.	Be disciplined in your Bible study.
2 Timothy 3:10	Do whatever you do with care, knowing how important and influential it will be. Do it, always having faith in God. Do it, always with godly attitudes, honoring your mentors and those you mentor.	Be a person who values your mentors and follows both their teachings and examples. Be patient and full of love.
